The successful candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate *[and graduate]* courses and to provide leadership in enhancing teaching and learning through curricular and pedagogical innovation *[and support aspects of curriculum delivery and development, etc.]*. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. All York University positions are subject to budgetary approval.

A Ph.D. *[or a Ph.D. near completion] [by the start of the appointment] [or PhD equivalent – specialized doctorate, such as an Ed.D or MA/MFA with a substantial record of professional experience]* in *[specific area or specific area or a related field]* is required.

The successful candidate will demonstrate excellence or clear potential for excellence in teaching university-level courses, a strong commitment to pedagogy and student success and the capacity to bring a theoretical and practical orientation to *[area]* teaching, learning and program design. A record of pedagogical innovation in high priority areas such as experiential education, technology enhanced learning and community-based learning is preferred as is experience with curriculum development and universal design approaches to teaching and assessment. The successful candidate is also expected to provide evidence of service contributions or potential to contribute to service in administrative and committee work.
